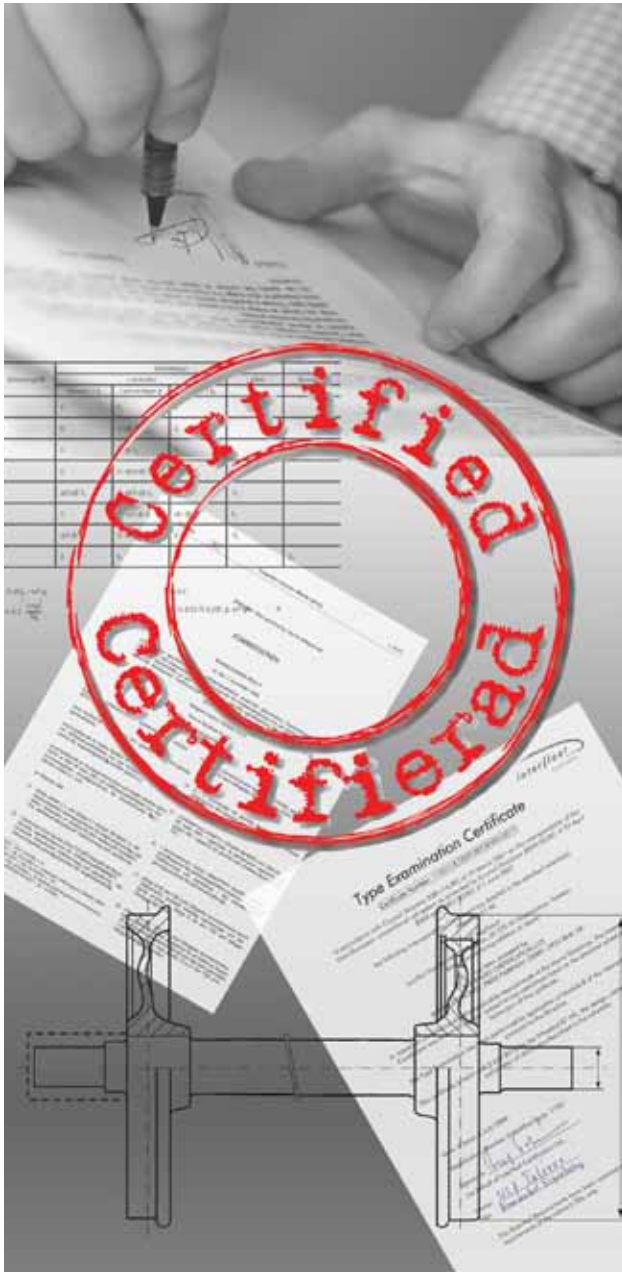




Notified Body – Certification According to TSI



Today the market requires cross-border transports, therefore national rail regulations have been replaced by European directives. Notified Body are independent auditors that have been designated to issue the certificates necessary to fulfil EU directives.

EU's technical specifications for interoperability (TSI) includes, among other things:

- standardization of components
- interoperability
- railway safety, for example fulfilling safety levels when introducing new or revised subsystems
- registering and labelling rail vehicles.

The legal requirement of certification regards infrastructure, all new rail vehicles, refurbished vehicles, and components such as wheels, axles, bogies and couplers. The Swedish Rail Inspection is responsible for the processes which lead to approval according to the TSI requirements.

Interfleet Certification is certified as Notified Body in Europe and accredited to assess correspondence with all TSI's. Interfleet Certification is a part of the Interfleet Technology group and it is individually certified to make independent audits worldwide.

We undertake assignments that comprise independent scrutiny of all types of components and subsystems. During certification work we cooperate closely with government agencies and testing labs. Our experience and broad knowledge of railway technologies provide us with the ability to quickly bring us into the task at hand and therefore be effective in our audit. In addition to certification we offer services for other parts of the approval processes, for example impartial third-party inspections.
